## Day 1 Monday 25th May

Travel the M1 motorway pausing for morning tea at Bulahdelah and Nambucca Heads for lunch. A short drive from Nambucca will see us arrive at The Lodge Bellingen our home for the next 3 nights. The Lodge Bellingen is the ultimate destination set on 16 acres of manicured lawns with uninterrupted spectacular mountain views. Relax in luxury accommodation and enjoy exploring the grounds, feeding the alpacas or taking a dip in the heated mineral spa.

## Day 2 Tuesday 26th May

Today explore the Dorrigo region. The countryside is a picture with green rolling hills. Cattle properties and the famous Dorrigo potato fields as you travel west to the Dutton trout Hatchery, located on the Serpentine River near Ebor, Dutton produces Rainbow and Brown Trout is one of two NSW Government facilities for breeding and rearing premier cold-water sport fish. After a 10- minute DVD we take a guided tour of the facility. A short drive will see us arrive at Ebor Falls, subject to previous rainfall see the Guy Fawkes River plunging 100 metres over the waterfall at Ebor Falls. The lookout platform along the edge of the gorge provides spectacular views out onto the rugged gorge country. Enjoy lunch and some free time in Dorrigo to explore the village before visiting the Dorrigo rainforest Centre on the edge of the escarpment with amazing views right to the coast. In addition to the Skywalk high above the forest there is a short walk for those that may like to take it.

## Day 3 Wednesday 27th May

This Morning we will be provided with an insight into the unique character of Bellingen and the surrounding valley as you explore the town and nearby countryside. Travel alongside the tranquil Bellinger River. Dairy and other farms thrive in the rich soil surrounding the Bellinger Township, enjoy a break in Bellingen before we take a short drive to Urunga for morning tea. When visiting Urunga a walk along the famous Boardwalk is a must. Lunch today will be at the V Wall Tavern at Nambucca Heads. After lunch take a stroll along the break-wall and view the array of artwork on the giant concrete boulders that were used in its construction. We will have time to explore the retail centre of Nambucca Heads before making our way back to Bellingen.

We farewell Bellingen and return to the M1 Hwy travelling through Coffs Harbour to Woolgoolga for morning tea. A short drive will see us arrive in the Grafton, famous for its Jacaranda trees. You will have free time to explore the many retail stores and cafes in this beautiful city. We then continue our travels along the Gwydir Highway arriving in Glenn Innes mid-afternoon.

## Day 5 Friday 29th May

Today we travel north to the NSW and Queensland border to visit Wallangarra Railway Station, stand with one foot in NSW and one foot in Queensland when you stand on the platform at the historic Station. The railway at Wallangarra was built in 1888 to service travellers who had to change trains from the standard gauge of New South Wales to Queensland's narrow gauge, note the differing architecture of the facades as well, one side of the platform reflects the New South Wales standard design for railways of that era, with skillion roof, while the other is Queensland bullnose verandah roof. When in Tenterfield a visit to the Tenterfield Saddler made famous by Peter Allen is a must. We will have some free time for lunch in Tenterfield before returning to Glen Innes.

## Day 6 Saturday 30th May

After breakfast this morning we travel to Inverell Pioneer Village, wander through the grounds to discover the Grove homestead, dating back to 1840, it was originally located in Tingha during the height of the early tin mining days, it is the oldest building in the village and depicts the early settler's homes. One of the highlights of the village is Paddy's Pub built in 1874 and previously located at Stanborough. Still in Inverell our next stop is at the National Transport Museum. One of North West New England region's most popular attractions. With over 250 vehicles exhibits it showcases an impressive collection of Vintage, Classic, Modern and commercial vehicles, along with motorcycles. Highlights include a rare 1906 Dayton, believed to be the only one left in the world, a 1912 Renault, a 1926 Diana, a 1929 Packard and a wide range of Chevrolets, Holdens, Fords, including GT Falcons. We will arrive in Moree in time for a relaxing swim in the artesian pools that are located on site at our accommodation
